



## First round of the call for energy renovation of public sector buildings

As part of the Call for energy renovation and use of RES in public sector buildings, a total of 300 Contracts have been signed for the total contracted value of projects over 1.1 billion kuna, while total grants amount to over 571 million kuna.

The Call was published on January 15th 2018, but it was suspended for a certain period due to fact that total requested grants reached 200% of total allocated resources, therefore total grants under this call were raised from original 380 million to 1.1 billion kuna.

Second round of the Call reopened on September 4th 2018 and was suspended again until February 5th 2019 as the total allocation of 1.1 billion kuna was exceeded.

During the second round of this Call 62 Financing Decisions were passed with project values amounting to more than 323 million kuna, while total grants amounted to more than 162 million kuna. 18 Contracts for energy renovation of public sector buildings were signed with total grants amounting to over 37 million kuna.

## Energy renovation of buildings for almost 70 000 students and children

Since 2015 Ministry of Construction and Physical Planning, as an intermediary body of level 1, opened four Calls for energy renovation of buildings whose applicants were eligible institutions that carry out the activities of education and training.

By December 2018 over 400 grant agreements were passed for energy renovation of kindergartens, schools of local, primary and secondary levels and colleges. Total value of the projects amounts to over 1.44 billion kuna, while the total amount of grants allocated by the European Regional Development Fund is almost 670 million kuna.

One of the main criteria of the Call is saving at least 50% of energy consumption on heating and cooling (Q<sub>h,n,d</sub>) which will be achieved through the implementation of measures to increase the thermal protection of the envelope, mechanical and electrical measures and the introduction of renewable energy sources. Implementing the kindergarten, school and college renovation projects will not only contribute to achieving goals set at European union level, but will also ensure that children and employees of these institutions have a comfortable place to stay and learn at.

## Energy renovation of over 200 multiapartment buildings is finalized

Within the Call for "Energy renovation of multiapartment buildings" 584 Contracts, that are co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund, have been signed so far.

Total value of the projects is over billion kunas, while the allocations from the European Regional Development Fund is over 554 million kuna. As of now over 200 multiapartment buildings have been renovated.
